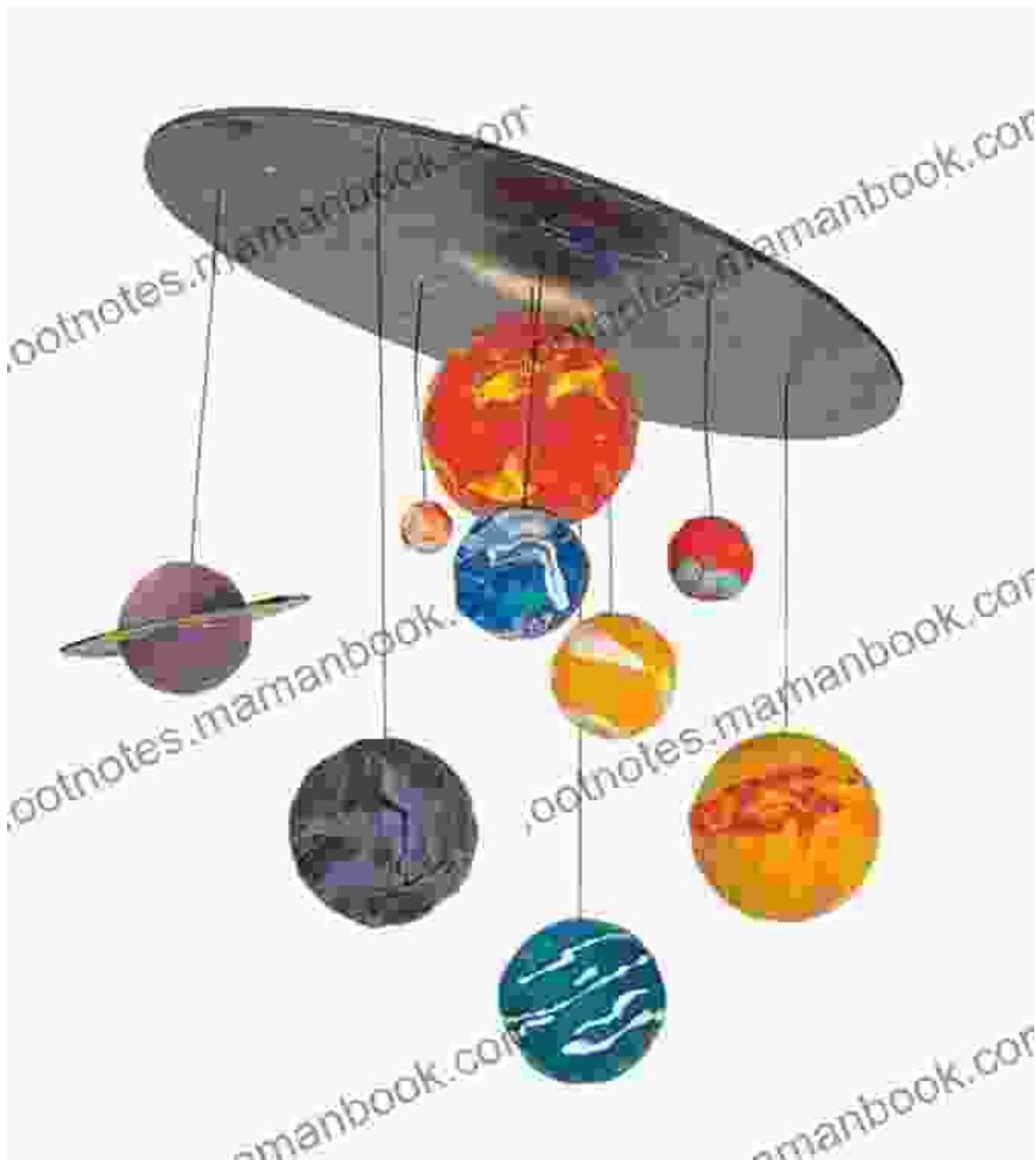

This fun and colorful project is a great way to teach kids about wind and how it can be used to power things.



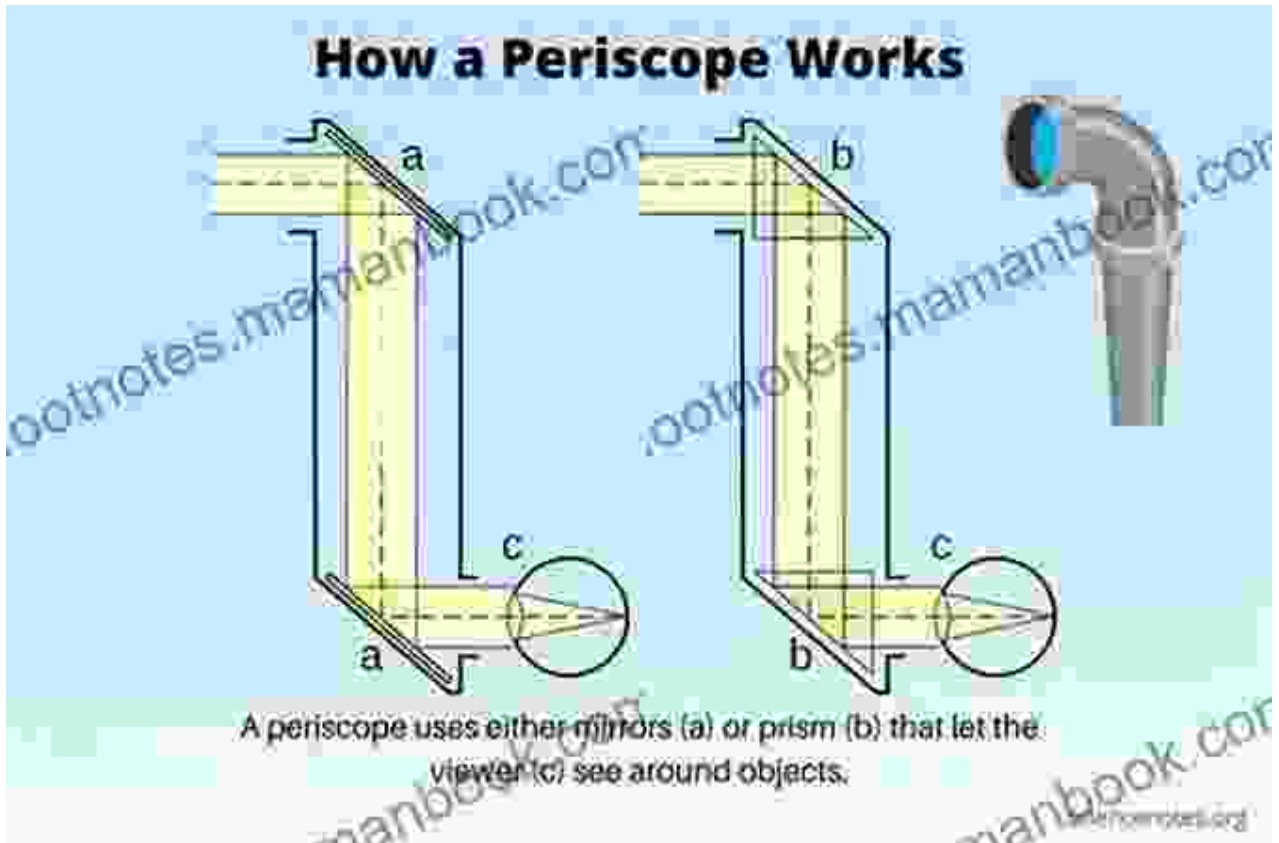
## 10. Create a Paper Airplane

This fun and educational project is a great way to teach kids about weather and how it can be measured.



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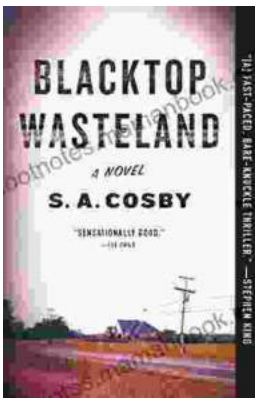
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
