Materials You'll Need

* Worsted-weight yarn in a variety of colors (for the fruits and the background) * Crochet hook size G (4.00 mm) * Yarn needle * Scissors * Measuring tape or ruler

Instructions

Basic Granny Square

1. Make a slip knot and leave a tail of yarn for sewing.
2. Chain 4 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
3. Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet).
4. *2 double crochets in the ring; chain 2; repeat from * 3 more times.
5. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the first double crochet.
6. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

Potholder

1. Make 4 basic granny squares. 2. Join the granny squares together by sewing around the outside edges with yarn and a yarn needle. 3. Make a border around the potholder by crocheting a single crochet stitch around the outside edge. 4. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

Hot Pad

1. Make 2 basic granny squares. 2. Join the granny squares together by sewing around the outside edges with yarn and a yarn needle. 3. Make a border around the hot pad by crocheting a single crochet stitch around the outside edge. 4. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

Fruit Appliqués

Apple

1. Make a magic circle and join with a slip stitch. 2. Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). 3. *2 double crochets in the circle; chain 2; repeat from * 11 more times. 4. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the first double crochet. 5. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing. 6. Sew the apple onto the potholder or hot pad. 7. Embroider the stem and leaf with a few stitches of green yarn.

Banana

1. Chain 5 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring. 2. Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). 3. *2 double crochets in the ring; chain 1; repeat from * 7 more times. 4. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the first double crochet. 5.

Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing. 6. Sew the banana onto the potholder or hot pad.

Orange

1. Make a magic circle and join with a slip stitch. 2. Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). 3. *2 double crochets in the circle; chain 1; repeat from * 15 more times. 4. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the first double crochet. 5. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing. 6. Sew the orange onto the potholder or hot pad.

Strawberry

1. Make a magic circle and join with a slip stitch. 2. Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). 3. *2 double crochets in the circle; chain 1; repeat from * 11 more times. 4. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the first double crochet. 5. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing. 6. Embroider the seeds with a few stitches of black yarn. 7. Sew the strawberry onto the potholder or hot pad.

Watermelon

1. Make a magic circle and join with a slip stitch. 2. Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet). 3. *2 double crochets in the circle; chain 1; repeat from * 15 more times. 4. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the first double crochet. 5. Fasten off and leave a tail of yarn for sewing. 6. Embroider the rind with a few stitches of black yarn. 7. Embroider the seeds with a few stitches of brown yarn. 8. Sew the watermelon onto the potholder or hot pad.

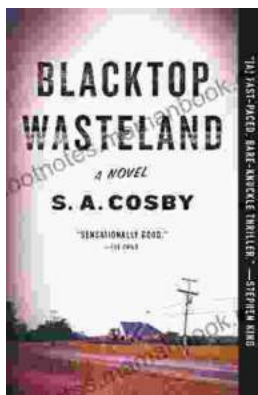
